This 411 supersedes the current guidelines outlined in the applicable Program Matrices. All updated guidelines will be highlighted and the matrices will show a revised date once they have been modified.

FHA Transactions - Handrails

Effective immediately, when an appraisal on a property is missing handrails on interior or exterior stairs, porches, and/or decks, and there are 3 or more stairs <u>or</u> stairs exceeding 18 inches, and the appraiser did not make the appraisal report subject to that repair, the appraiser must make a specific comment that states, "Stairs and railings meet HUD's minimum property requirements and are not a safety issue." **Note:** AFR Underwriter has the discretion after full review of the appraisal report for final determination if the requirement of handrails is required.

Conventional Financing – Manufactured Housing REMINDER

Please refer to the chart below for what documentation is needed when the HUD Data Plate and/or HUD Tags are missing on a manufactured house for Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac financing.
